ANTI-BULLYING WEEK 12th - 16th November

We will be taking part in Anti-bullying week, which we will launch on the Monday with... **ODD SOCKS DAY Monday 12th November**— A day to celebrate difference. Odd Socks Day is designed to be fun! It's an opportunity for children to express themselves and celebrate their individuality and what makes us all unique!

All children come into school with 2 odd socks on.

If they wear tights wear socks over the tights.

Only have grey socks? Wear one inside out!

Children can also wear odd socks throughout anti bullying week if they wish.

RANDOM ACTS OF KINDNESS

KINDNESS SYMBOL – A secret, silent gesture that children/teachers/parents can do to each other to acknowledge an act of kindness.

The Peer supporters will also have special kindness stickers that they will be handing out at break and lunch that week for any children they see carrying out random acts of kindness.

CHANGES TO BUS REGISTERS

FLU VACCINATION

Somerset SAINT (school aged immunisation nursing team) will be visiting both Rode and Norton St Philip Schools on Thursday 15th November to administer the nasal spray flu vaccination. If you have given permission for your child to have the vaccination please could you inform the school if any of the below apply to your child:

- if your child is wheezy on the day of vaccination, or has been wheezy in the three days prior to this date
- is asthmatic and has had to increase his or her asthma medication since you returned the consent form
- if there are any other changes in your child's health since you returned the consent form
- if your child has already received the flu vaccine via their GP recently, it is **really important** that you inform the school otherwise your child may be immunised again because Somerset SAINT may still hold a consent form for them.
