



BFG Class - Crest of a Wave - Summer

This term BFG's are learning about a *Crest of a Wave*. We will be **inspiring** the children by visiting the Earth Science Centre and Whatley Quarry. The children will **discover** all the human and physical features of the British landscape and **create** and design their own competition entry for the quarry restoration project. Children will be given the opportunity to **explore** the science behind sound waves and identify how sounds are made and travel. They will find patterns in sound through music and learning drumming beats. At the end of our learning the children will **flourish** in a carnival procession where we will march through the streets of Rode and share our learning with the community.
